

Project call: **VISITING SCIENTIST** (1-2 months)

Deadline: February 28, 2017

The Center of Theoretical Physics of Grenoble-Alpes (CPTGA) announces the opening of positions for

Visiting Scientists in Theoretical Physics.

The CPTGA aims to animate scientific exchanges in theoretical physics in the region Grenoble-Alpes, bringing together several teams and communities. In this context, we request inter-laboratory proposals to welcome a visiting scientist in one of the areas of theoretical physics represented in the region Grenoble-Alpes. New collaborations are encouraged.

The positions to be attributed are for 1 or 2 months. The CPTGA expects the invited researcher to organize a mini-workshop in connection with his or her scientific activities during the stay.

Eligibility:

- The position is to be filled in 2017.
- The visiting researcher must hold a position in their home institution outside of France. Furthermore, he or she must be below the French age limit (65) for retirement.

The position will cover the salary (level "DR" at the CNRS) of the visiting scientist. Any additional costs must be covered by the host laboratories.

Application: Please submit before February 28, 2017 the following documents by email to julia.meyer@univ-grenoble-alpes.fr:

- CV of the visiting scientist
- description of the proposed research and the planned collaborations with different laboratories affiliated with the CPTGA (1-2 pages)
- commitment of the local collaborators

Selection: The applications will be reviewed by the executive committee of the CPTGA. The results will be announced in March 2017.
